OBJECTIVE

The INTREP project aims to promote social inclusion and diversity as well as intercultural and interfaith dialogue by supporting teachers and adult and community educators to foster social innovation and entrepreneurship in intercultural and interreligious contexts through Community Adult Education (ACE).

PARTNERS

A multi-sectoral partnership of eight expert organizations in social innovation, intercultural and interreligious dialogue, and entrepreneurship for adult community education.



PROJECT RESULTS

For this purpose, the consortium will co-design, develop, test, and mainstream the following innovative and OER freely accessible :

- **PR1.** Training curriculum
- **PR2.** Learning Units Plan of learning experiences, activities, and types of learning
- **PR3.** E-Learning Campus, an ICT-based educative instrument to upskill Adult and community teachers and educators allowing them to create their e-learning courses
- **PR4.** Instructional Web App, an innovative ICT-based tool
- **PR5.** Recommendations for skills validation, certification, and accreditation on Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship in Intercultural and Interreligious contexts through ACE.
