

First Transnational Meeting (TPM1) in Valladolid



The first transnational meeting (TPM1) of the **ECOTEACH** project was successfully completed in Valladolid, Spain, coordinated by the Directorate of Secondary Education of Lasithi (DSEL).



The meeting took place on Thursday, May 8, 2025, within the framework of the European project **ECOTEACH -Teaching science and maths through innovative models of Environment Based Learning for disadvantaged schools and students (2024-1-EL01-KA220-SCH-000251462)** - within the framework of the Erasmus+ program (Action KA220 – Partnerships in school education).

During the meeting, the partners had the opportunity to get to know each other, to reaffirm their common orientation and to discuss in detail the timeline, the responsibilities of each partner and the first actions of the project.



Particular emphasis was given to identifying the key competencies required by teachers for the effective teaching of mathematics and science through environmental approaches. The partners exchanged views on the design of the ECOTEACH Virtual Classroom online platform, which will be used for teacher training, as well as on the architecture of the Toolkit, which will include guidelines, methodologies and practical tools for the integration of environmental education into school practice.



The meeting was hosted by the organization Plataforma HABITAT (Spain), in a particularly collaborative and inspiring atmosphere, where the foundations were laid for a substantial and productive collaboration, with the common goal of the successful implementation of an innovative and high-quality project.
