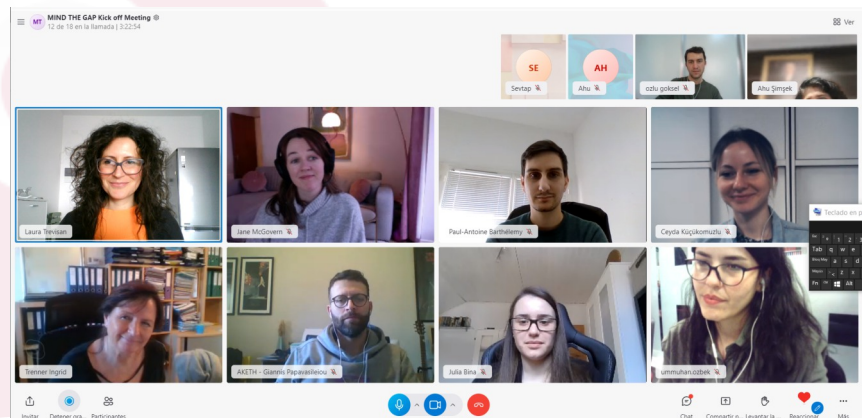

During the meeting, a detailed presentation of the whole project and all the intellectual products was made. At the end of the meeting the project partners discussed the next steps to be taken.





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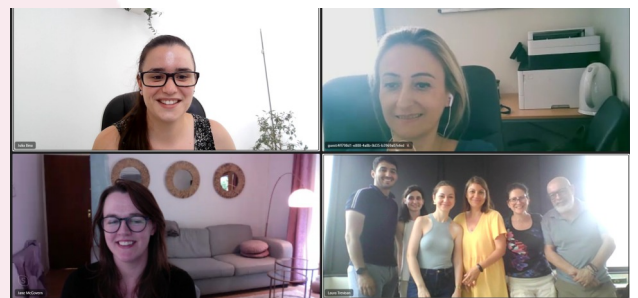
## 2nd Transnational Project Meeting

The second transnational project meeting was held on 28/6/2022 in Bastia, France. Some of the partners participated to the meeting via Skype.

In the meeting there was a detailed presentation, discussion and determination of the learning units among partners. The next steps of the project were discussed and an overview of the dissemination plan, activities, administrative and financial issues, was presented.

Specifically, the following activities took place:

- Presentation of the Theoretical and Methodological Framework for Contemporary Digital Skills for Adults
- Overview of analysis of theoretical and methodological framework to define learning modules for the curriculum
- Review of the technical implementation of the platform and instructional guide for the development of the training modules
- Presentation of the work plan for the practical guideline for overcoming the challenges in adult learning
- National online surveys to define themes and contents of the webinars and instructional videos (instructions and implementation)





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## 3rd Transnational Project Meeting

The third transnational project meeting was held on 13/10/2022 in Dublin, Ireland. Some of the partners participated to the meeting via Skype.

In the meeting there were presentations of the progress in the project results (Pr1, Pr2, Pr3, Pr4). The next steps of the project were reaffirmed, and a review of the dissemination plan, activities, administrative and financial issues, was held based on the unfolded progression so far and the follow-ups that would be required.

- Presentation of the work plan to create the practical guideline for overcoming the challenges in adult learning
- Presentation of the work plan to develop the webinar/instructional videos for digital migrants in virtual world







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## 4th Transnational Project Meeting

The fourth transnational project meeting was held on 14/02/2023 on the premises of Anaptixiako Kentro Thessalias in Trikala, Greece. Some of the partners participated in the meeting via Skype.

In the meeting, there were presentations on the progress of the project results (R3 and R4). The next steps of the project were reaffirmed and a review of dissemination activities, and administrative and financial issues, was held based on the unfolded progression so far and the follow-ups that would be required.





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## Training Activity & Piloting

The Training Activity of the "MIND THE GAP" was held in Istanbul, Turkiye on 16-17-18/05/2023. Project Result 3 "E-learning platform including digital-ed modules for the contemporary digital skills for digital migrants" and Project Result 4 "Webinars / Instructional Videos as maps directly for digital migrants in virtual world" was presented.

In July, we conducted a piloting test for our e-learning platform. The results were overwhelmingly positive, confirming that our user-friendly interface and instructional videos/webinars empower older learners to embrace digital education with confidence.







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## Multiplier Events

We are thrilled to share the exciting outcomes of the "Mind the Gap" project's recent multiplier events that took place across our eight partner countries last month. These events served as crucial milestones in our mission to bridge the gap between individuals familiar with modern technology and those experiencing social exclusion due to their lack of familiarity.
